INSTRUCTIONS FOR ATTENDING TUNELESS CHOIR ROTHERHAM – THANK YOU FOR MAKING IT SAFE TO SING

- Arriving at the Whiston Parish Hall, Well Lane. Additional parking is available at the Golden Ball pub down the road and members are welcome encouraged to visit them for a drink occasionally, please follow their covid guidelines. Please observe the 2m rule in the car parks and while walking into the hall and please wear your mask until you are sat down in the hall, if you are exempt from wearing a mask please let me know. Please enter using the main entrance only and exit using the side exit door only. These are clearly marked with other covid safe signs that must be observed and followed. Please do not move the chairs as these are set out at a safe distance. Hand sanitizer will be at the entrance and exit points, please use this on arrival and before you leave.
- Track and trace, it is advisable to download the NHS Track and Trace app and scan our Tuneless barcode to confirm your attendance on the app, this will help to fight the virus
- Symptoms. Of course if you have any symptoms of covid please do not attend the session, if you have pre paid you will be refunded
- Please use the toilet before the session or you are welcome to go during the sessions avoid you need, to avoid queuing at break times. The toilets are 1 person in at any one time, please observe and follow the signs on the doors
- Arrival time, please arrive as between 7.15 and 7.30 and take your seats as soon as possible, we ask that after the session you leave the hall as quickly and safely as possible, always observing the 2m rule and wearing your mask until you are off the premises
- Meeting others, please arrange to meet anyone you would like to come with (same row but 2m apart) before you enter the building
- Registration, you will be asked to collect a registration form as you enter the hall, these will be in reception on a table so please take one as you come in, complete it before or after the session or during the break and leave the completed form on the stage at the rear of the room before you leave, observe the 2m rule at all times please
- What to bring. Please bring a facemask, a pen, a jacket (as the windows and doors will be open for ventilation) and a bottle of water, and or a snack for break time
- -Tickets/Payment All tickets and places for launch night must be pre booked and tickets purchased online, if you cannot buy online please get in touch and other contactless arrangements can be made

- Payment for sessions after launch night can be done online via bank transfer or a contactless card machine is in use at reception, please stay at 2m whilst waiting to pay and please wear your mask. Please move straight into the hall and take your seat immediately after paying
- Contactless payments are preferred but cash payments can be made with the correct amount in an named and dated envelope placed in a basket in reception. This must be pre arranged as your place will still need to be booked so please let me know.
- Signs are up in and around the hall, please observe these at all times
 - And finally..... the singing! The words for the songs will be on a projector screen on the wall for us all to follow and the leader Becky will be stood at the front at safe distance to lead the songs and operate the music. Please sing like no one is listening and let yourself go! Whilst we may break into a gentle sway or clapping, please try to stay in front of your chair where ever possible so we do not breach the 2m rule. Due to covid there will be no conga lines at our sessions for the time being.

These rules are set by the government and we are indeed breaking the law if we fail to follow them. The sessions will still be a huge amount of fun as long as we are singing like no one is listening!
